

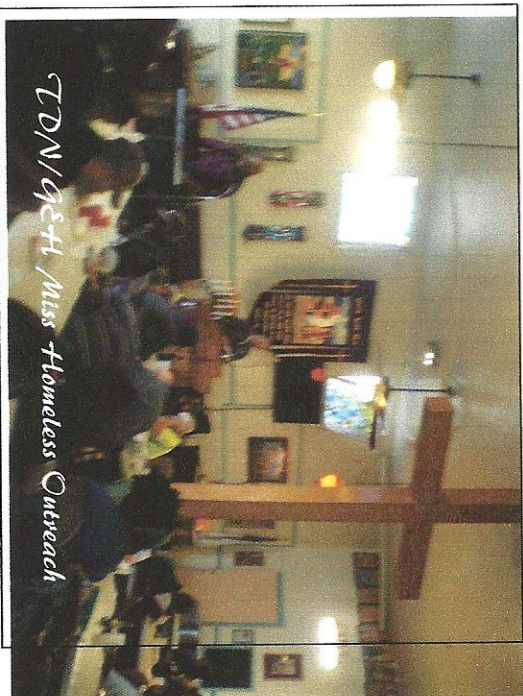

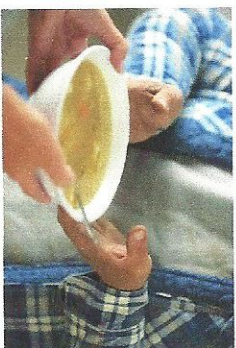

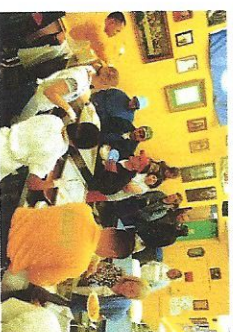


“Our Nation Shuns Its Homeless”
