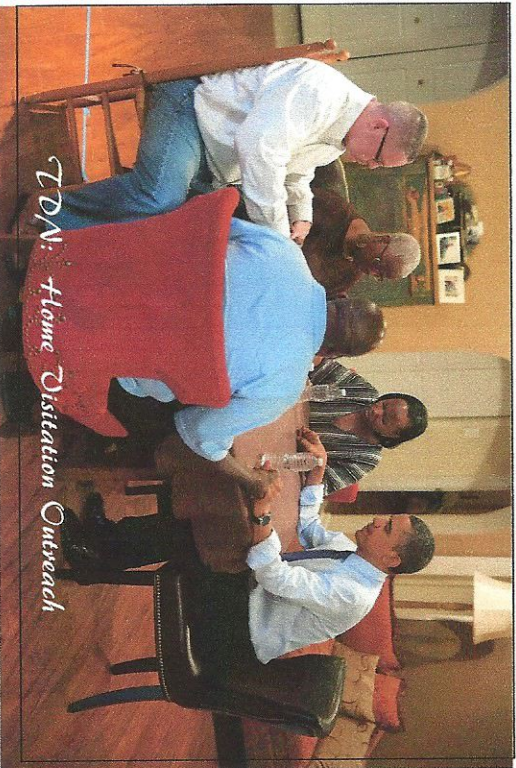

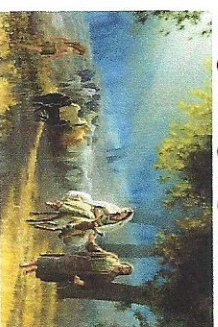


“What Can Be Gained By Home Visitations?”
